

# Conversation Cards:

**The Goal:** The goal of these cards is to spark fun, light-hearted conversations with your children about the Bible and its teachings. These questions are not designed to lead them to a “right” answer. Instead, they invite children to share their current knowledge and understanding of the question asked. This also creates natural opportunities for parents to teach and guide their children based on their current level of understanding.

**How to use these cards:** These cards can be used as conversation starters at the dinner table, in the car, or during family time. They also pair well with games such as UNO, Candyland, Jenga, or any other game your family enjoys. When it’s a player’s turn, they simply answer a question before completing their turn.

Parents are encouraged to approach these cards with curiosity and openness. The purpose is not to correct your children or point out wrong answers, but to better understand what they already know and believe. These conversations may naturally open the door to teaching moments that build upon your child’s existing knowledge. The questions were created with children in grades 2–5 in mind, but feel free to adjust or rephrase them for younger or older children. Blank cards are included to allow families to create their own questions or address topics their children are already curious about.
