

SING WORSHIP MUSIC TOGETHER

Create a daily or weekly rhythm of singing or listening to worship music as a family.

- Sing together, or play worship music in the background during the day
- Talk about the lyrics and why worship matters

Use this time to invite God's presence into your home

SIMPLE WAYS TO HELP YOUR KIDS ENGAGE WITH GOD

MEMORIZE SCRIPTURE TOGETHER

Make learning God's Word fun and memorable for your kids:

- Say the verse using silly voices
- Sing the verse to a familiar tune—or make up your own song
- Create actions to go along with the words

Scriptures to start with
Psalm 119:11, Psalm 119:105, John 3:16,
Acts 2:38, John 1:1

"PLAY CHURCH"

Kids love learning through play! Set up a pretend church service at home.

- Use stuffed animals or toys as the congregation
- Let your kids choose the worship music
- Invite them to preach a message or lead a prayer

This helps faith feel approachable, joyful, and part of everyday life.

PRAY SCRIPTURE TOGETHER

Choose a passage of Scripture—Psalms and Proverbs are great places to start—and pray it together as a family.

- Talk about what the Scripture means
- Invite your kids to share ideas on how you can pray that Scripture over each other or someone you know

Use the words of Scripture as a guide for your prayers

READ SCRIPTURE OUT LOUD AS A FAMILY

To make this time more engaging:

- Connect Bible reading to routines you already have, such as mealtime, bedtime, or car rides (audio Bibles work great!)
- After reading, share a thought, question, or observation to model engagement with Scripture
- Allow kids to do something quiet with their hands while listening, like building with Legos, using play-dough, or drawing
